

Project Update – October 2020

Internal Renovation Project – Redeemer Hall, Administration and Accessibility

The internal renovation project consists of the following components:

- Renovation of Redeemer Hall – new ceiling and lights , new toilets, a shower, new kitchen and servery, storage, full paint, polished floor
- New passenger elevator serving all levels of the parish hall
- New toilets on the current office floor level
- New front office on Level 1, a new rector’s office and pastoral meeting room on Level 2
- New multi-functional ministry space above the balcony of the current dance studio
- New floor and wall finishes to the vestibule and new lights
- New electrical distribution panels for the church and Redeemer Hall
- New windows for the Woolsey Building
- Bathroom renovation for the rectory, new wardrobe shelving, painting and some repairs
- Air conditioning to the choir room and rectory
- New accessible ramps from sidewalk to forecourt
- New exterior signage and lighting
- Landscaping to the front garden beds
- Repair of the sanctuary floor in front of the chancel

The project was recommenced in August 2020. The current schedule indicates:

- Design development – September to November
- Parish consultation – Online – early November 2020
- Construction documents prepared – December and January 2021
- Bid contract – January / February 2021
- Commence construction – April 2021
- Target completion – September 2021
